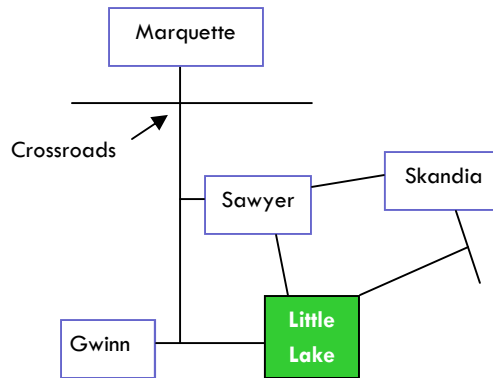
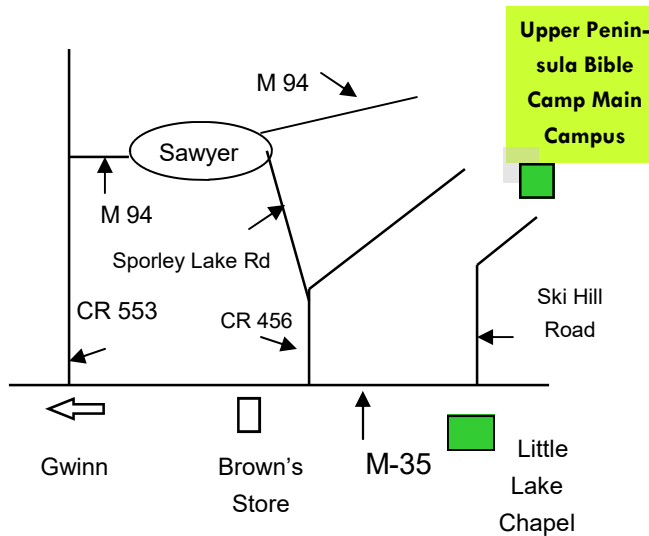

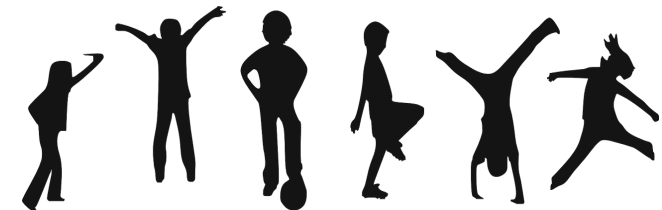
## Little Lake Chapel Sunday Services
